The Public Health and Safety Committee Meeting was called to order at 6:47 P.M. by Chairperson, Amy Michael.

The only item was to agree to Optum Health's change of eligibility policy.

Optum Health is changing their eligibility policy from 60 years old to 18 years old. Anyone that has United Healthcare as a primary insurance provider can get a free gym membership. The policy pays the RAC directly for gym visits and there is no exchange of money. The item would be to accept the change in eligibility.
