The Streets & Sidewalks Committee Meeting was called to order at 6:10 P.M. by Matt Harper.

The first item was a RFP for the City's Street Tree Inventory.

Mr. Harper stated that the item is for the City's street tree inventory which is done every seven years and noted that the cost has tripled.

The item was moved forward.

The second item was a payment to ODOT for Main St. Paving.

Mr. Harper stated that the item is to approve the City's share of the project cost in the sum of \$626,556. He said that if the project cost is less than the proposed cost, then the remainder of the funds will be given back to the City.

The third item was a contract with Ohio Paving & Construction Co.

Mr. Harper stated that the item is for the paving of the police garage parking lot and the Maple Grove Cemetery main drive, adding that the project bid came in under budget.

The item was moved forward.

The fourth item was a contract with Karvo Companies for the Chestnut/Prospect resurfacing project.

Mr. Harper stated that the item is to pave N. Chestnut and S. Prospect St. He explained that the City received grants to pay for 90% of the Prospect St. and 80% of the Chestnut St. paving projects.

Management Update

Mr. Finney stated that they will be laying brick tomorrow on S. Freedom St. and that the widening of W. Main St. is underway and will be done before Main St. gets paved.
