



**Ravenna City Council
Utilities Committee Meeting Minutes
March 11, 2024**

The public meeting was held in Ravenna City Council Chambers.

Utility Committee Meeting was called to order at 6:23 P.M. by Chairperson, Paul Moskun.

The first item was the removal and replacement of the Rt. 14 water tower.

Mr. Moskun explained that the current water tower is 3 million gallons and that the new tower will be 750,000 gallons.

Ms. West asked when the project would start.

Mr. Moskun stated that the City needs to get bids for the project first.

Mr. Finney stated that the tank will take approximately 1 year to build and that he is looking at 3 tank manufacturers that have similar styles of towers with concrete slabs.

- The item was moved forward.

The second item was a 2-year Industrial Pretreatment Contract.

Mr. Moskun stated that the contract would be with CT Consultants who the City has worked with for many years and said that they are a high-quality company.

Ms. West asked if the contract price had increased.

Mr. Moskun stated that he was unsure.

Mr. Finney explained that CT Consultants get paid when they are used, and that they serve the City on an as needed basis.

Mr. Contant stated that the industrial pretreatment contract is for technical assistance.

- The item was moved forward.

There being no further business for discussion, the meeting adjourned at 6:29 P.M.
