



**Ravenna City Council
Utilities Committee Meeting Minutes
August 12, 2024**

The public meeting was held in Ravenna City Council Chambers.

Utility Committee Meeting was called to order at 7:32 P.M. by Chairperson, Paul Moskun.

The first item was the Maplewood lift station.

Mr. Moskun explained that due to a vehicle accident the lift station needs to be replaced from the ground up and that the City is currently utilizing rented equipment. He said that the final cost is unknown, but an approximate estimate is \$130,000 and the City is trying to get restitution through the courts to recoup expenses.

Mr. Finney stated the temporary pump rental is \$2,025 a month.

The second item was the chemicals for the Water and Wastewater Plants for 2025.

Mr. Moskun explained that the item is for the chemicals that are required by the EPA which the EPA tracks at each facility.
