



**Ravenna City Council  
Public Health and Safety Committee Meeting Minutes  
July 14, 2025**

**The public meeting was held in person in City Council Chambers.**

**The Public Health and Safety Committee Meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Chairperson, Amy Michael.**

**The first item was to accept a \$2,915.48 EMS grant for the Fire Department.**

Ms. Michael explained that the item was to accept an EMS grant for the Fire Department in the amount of \$2,915.48, to be used for equipment or training. She noted the grant required no local match and recommended moving it forward.

- The item was moved forward.

**Management Update**

Ms. Michael shared she is awaiting discussion with the Law Director on how to better enforce the City's loitering ordinance. She emphasized concern over public camping, particularly in the pocket park, and supports placing signage to prevent it from becoming a camping area. Ms. Michael also called for greater accountability from Coleman Health Services regarding their outreach efforts downtown, especially given funding changes and staffing transitions.

Ms. Michael then referenced a Kent ordinance imposing penalties and restrictions on businesses that are shut down due to illegal activity, suggesting a similar measure be considered in Ravenna to prevent such businesses from easily reopening. She stressed the importance of tightening ordinances to protect the community.
