Utilities Committee Meeting Minutes
April 13, 2026**

The public meeting was held in Ravenna City Council Chambers.

Utility Committee Meeting was called to order at 6:14 P.M. by Chairperson, Paul Moskun.

The first item was the purchase of a 2026 Silverado.

Mr. Moskun presented a request to purchase a 2026 three-quarter-ton Chevrolet truck for the Water Treatment Plant to replace a 2009 model that is no longer cost-effective to maintain. He explained that the vehicle was custom-built to meet the department's operational needs, including towing equipment trailers and plowing snow at multiple Water Department facilities. The truck will be equipped with a gas engine and snowplow package and will be purchased through Cleveland Motorsports in Garrettsville at a price lower than the State purchasing contract.

Ms. Laudato noted that \$65,000 had been appropriated for the purchase and that the final cost is \$7,497.60 below the approved budget amount.

Mr. Calfee asked what would happen with the replaced vehicle.

Mr. Moskun stated that the 2009 truck will be sold at auction, with proceeds remaining within the Water Treatment Department.
